Thames Valley Park is one of Europe's best business developments. Attractive modern office buildings set in a country park with a mile of river frontage offers many recreational, leisure and social opportunities from jogging to bird-watching and the shopping! Many places of interest can also be reached on foot or cycle using the network of traffic free routes into Reading and beyond. Thames Valley Park is halfway along the 184 mile Thames Path running from the Cotswolds to the Thames Barrier at Greenwich. It is also on the National Cycle Networks routes 4

Route 4 travels east towards London past Thames Valley Park, Charvil and Twyford, and west past The Oracle shopping centre along the banks of the Kennet.

Route 5 travels north from the Thames through Caversham and Emmer Green to the Chilterns towards Oxford.
